

## Black Youth Housing Project: Call for Research Participants

Have you worked with Black youth who have experienced housing instability and homelessness in the Greater Toronto Area?

**Purpose:** this study will explore the experiences of Black youth who have experienced housing instability and homelessness, as well as service providers who have supported Black youth under these circumstances in the Greater Toronto Area. The findings will inform the development of a transitional home in the York Region.

**Criteria** We are recruiting service providers who have worked with African, Caribbean, and/or Black youth experiencing housing instability or homelessness in the last 5 years (2018-2023) to share their experiences supporting this population.

**Format** Online or in person 60-minute interview or 90-minute focus group

**Incentive** Participants will be compensated **\$40 e-Visa or cash**

**Consent** If you meet the study eligibility, you will receive an information letter outlining informed consent

Participation in this study is entirely voluntary. Participants can choose to withdraw at any time or not answer questions.
